My name is Kelechi Umoga, and I and Rebeca Vergara are the community service co-chairs of Yale Medical School's Student National Medical Association/Latino Student Medical Association (SNMA/LMSA) - the minority student groups at the medical school. We are currently planning our **5th Annual New Haven Community Health fair**, titled "**Party with a Purpose**," to be held on Yale's Day of Service, **Saturday, May 12th, 2018 from 10am-2pm** at the **Stetson Branch Library**.

The aim of our health fair this year is to empower minority residents of New Haven with health education and services that will benefit their future health and the health of their friends and family. The health fair will engage Yale Medical, Nursing, and Public Health Schools health professionals and students with health fair participants in a fun, lively, and family-friendly atmosphere.

This year, we also hope to recruit local and Yale providers, with a particular emphasis on providers of color, to best represent the communities of Greater New Haven that we will be serving.

Our health fair aims to provide basic health services such as blood pressure screenings, STI testing, blood sugar testing, nutrition education, etc., all at no cost to health fair participants, and in conjunction with organizations such as the Cornell Scott Hill Health Center and the Elm City Freddy Fixer Parade.

Health fair participants will have the opportunity to engage intimately with medical experts on the health issues and questions affecting their community. Furthermore, participants will be able to connect with local community organizations that specialize in social services, such as health insurance enrollment, transportation assistance, housing, job recruitment, refugee support services, and much more. There will be a DJ providing live music, line dancing for adults who love to dance, raffle prizes and much more!
